

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MULBERRY, KANSAS REGARDING THE GOVERNING BODY'S INTENT TO LEVY A PROPERTY TAX EXCEEDING THE REVENUE NEUTRAL RATE;

WHEREAS, the Revenue Neutral Rate for the City of Mulberry was calculated as 47.768 mills by the Crawford County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the budget proposed by the Governing Body of the City of Mulberry will require the levy of a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body intends to hold a hearing and hear testimony from all interested taxpayers desiring to be heard as required by state law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MULBERRY:

Section 1. The Governing Body of the City of Mulberry hereby sets a public hearing regarding its intention to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate for September 9th 2025 at 6:30pm to be held at Mulberry City Hall, 101 S Military Ave. Mulberry, KS, and directs that notice of the public hearing be given as required by state law.

Section 2. The Governing Body of the City of Mulberry expresses its intention to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate with a proposed mill levy of 53.517 mills.

Section 3. The Governing Body of the City of Mulberry directs the City Clerk to provide this resolution to the Crawford County Clerk as notice of the City's proposed intent to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate.

This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and shall remain in effect until future action is taken by the Governing Body.
